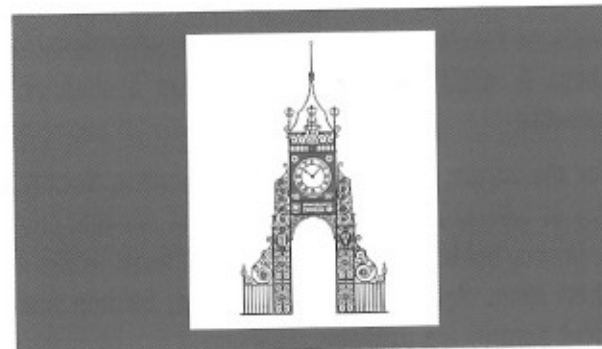

Listed Site



The Touring Park is most conveniently situated within 3 miles of the Roman city of Chester, and is easily accessible from the major road network, just off the A55.

Privately owned, the park accommodates 65 units, on hard standing if required, with 10amp electric points. There are large expanses of level and well kept grass as well as an extended tent area. There is a child's playing area on a safe surface, and plenty of playing space.



Local amenities include Multiscreen Cinemas, Theatre, Golf, Horse Racing, Swimming Pools, Canoeing, Boat Trips on the River Dee and a host of Exhibitions, Museums, Castles and Parks. Chester boasts a huge choice of fine Restaurants and Bars, and a lively and varied night life. The shops inside the walls, on two levels or 'Rows' combined with the local shops & retail outlets, make the area a shoppers paradise.

For the angler, courtesy of The Dee Angling Society, day or weekly permits can be issued at nominal cost to licence holders. There are a choice of beats within a short drive. As well as course fishing, Salmon and Trout permits are available.



For the comfort of our visitors we have good all night illumination, a camera system, automatic security barrier and individual keys to main gate and shower blocks. The park has a laundry room and a separate dish-washing and vegetable preparation room. Showers and all hot water is provided free.

In addition to being ideally located to enjoy the main amenities and delights of Chester, the park serves as the centre base for touring Cheshire, North and Mid Wales, The Borderlands, Delamere Forest and The Peak District. Manchester and Liverpool both are just 45 mins. by car and Holyhead about 90 mins.
